

## Macomb Health Plan

Macomb Health Plan, an independent non-profit organization not affiliated with Macomb County government, offers three health plans. Two plans are for low-income Macomb County residents. The third is for small businesses that do not currently offer health benefits to employees. The health plans are not services of Macomb County government.

### **Plan A – Macomb Health Plan (Adult Benefit Waiver/ABW Program)**

**Availability:**

Only during open enrollment periods determined by the state of Michigan

**Cost:** No monthly premium for qualified applicants

**Eligibility:**

- Macomb County residents
- Ages 19-64
- U.S. citizens
- Not disabled
- Not qualified for Medicaid or other medical programs
- Income less than 35 percent of federal poverty level (about \$200-\$250 per month)

(Eligibility determined by Michigan Department of Human Services)

### **Plan B – Macomb Care Connect**

**Availability:** Open enrollment

**Cost:** No monthly premium for qualified applicants

**Eligibility:**

- Macomb County residents
- Ages 19-64
- Adults with no minor dependent children
- Individual and spouse income 100 percent of federal poverty level, or less (about \$800 per month for individual, \$1,070 per month for individual and spouse)
- Not eligible for any other medical coverage (Medicare, Medicaid, retiree or any other commercial medical benefit)

**Information required for enrollment:**

- Completed application
- Current photo identification
- Medicaid rejection letter from Michigan Department of Human Services
- Proof of current address
- Copy of Social Security card
- Proof of individual and spouse income
- Bank statement and mortgage or lease statement
- Completed income/expenses form

Coverage starts at the beginning of the next month after approval of application. Once approved, members receive ID card and member handbook.

## **Plan C – Macomb Blue**

**Availability:** Open enrollment

**Cost:** Employer, employee and Macomb Health Plan each share one-third of the monthly premium. Call Macomb Health Plan for details.

**Eligibility:**

- Primary business location in Macomb County
- Up to 200 employees may be enrolled
- Employer has not offered or contributed to employee healthcare benefits in previous year
- Company must be in business at least six months
- Contact Macomb Health Plan for further requirements
