Bill Sowerby appointed to regional SMART board

MOUNT CLEMENS, Mich. – Macomb County Board of Commissioners Chair Paul Gielegem appointed Bill Sowerby of Clinton Township to represent Macomb County on the regional Suburban Mobility Authority for Regional Transportation (SMART) board.

The SMART Board develops overall policy for public transportation for Southeastern Michigan. Sowerby served before as a SMART board member. He served from 1992 to 1996.

Sowerby, 52, has been Clinton Township's treasurer since 1996 and is currently serving his third term. Prior to being elected treasurer, he was a Macomb County Commissioner representing Clinton Township from 1989 to 1996. Sowerby also represents Clinton Township on the Grosse Pointes-Clinton Refuse Disposal Authority Board.

In 2000, Sowerby helped establish the Annual Clinton Township Community Blood Drive. He also acts as a local coordinator for Green Michigan, a non-profit organization that seeks to keep the preservation of the environment a priority in Clinton Township and the county. He is a volunteer for Turning Point Domestic Violence and Sexual Assault Shelter. Sowerby has a Bachelor of Arts degree from Wayne State University.
