Macomb County seeks comments on Justice Assistance Grant

MOUNT CLEMENS, Mich. – The public is invited to review and comment on an application for a 2009 Justice Assistance Grant worth \$1,485,561 submitted by Macomb County Community Corrections, the Macomb County Sheriff's Office and local police.

The grant is awarded by the U.S. Department of Justice and is designed to provide funding to combat crime. The Macomb County local police departments participating in this grant are Warren, Center Line, Eastpointe, Fraser, Richmond, Roseville, St. Clair Shores, Sterling Heights, Chesterfield Township, Clinton Township and Shelby Township.

The grant application is available for review for 30 days between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. on regular business days beginning Wednesday, April 8, at Macomb County Office of Community Corrections, 43565 Elizabeth Road, Mount Clemens. The money from the grant will go toward the following law enforcement projects:

- The Macomb County Community Corrections jail diversion program for prisoners with substance abuse issues

- Replacement of outdated mobile computer terminals for Macomb County Sheriff's Office patrol cars
- Mobile computers and video equipment with supporting hardware for Warren police
- In-car mobile workstations and narcotics testing kits for Center Line police
- Replacement of outdated police equipment and communications equipment for Eastpointe police
- Card readers that will enable Fraser police to issue electronic tickets
- Officer safety equipment for Richmond police
- Replacement of old officer safety equipment and updating the records bureau system for Roseville police
- Patrol car equipment for St. Clair Shores police
- Patrol car video recorders for Sterling Heights police
- Crime scene investigation equipment and an electronic card access system for Chesterfield Township police
- Updating patrol car video cameras and a digital retention system for Clinton Township police
- Updating and improving communications equipment for Shelby Township police
