MOUNT CLEMENS, Mich. – The first Macomb County Senior Fun Festival features a grandchild photo contest that will help raise money for senior citizen programs.

Grandparents who are at least 60 years old and Macomb County residents can submit up to three photographs, which will be voted on during the Senior Fun Festival – 10 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Wednesday, June 17, at the Gibraltar Trade Center-North in Mount Clemens.

Here are the rules:

- Grandchildren depicted in photographs must be no older than 5 years old at the time the picture was taken
- Professional photographs and pictures larger than 5"x7" will not be accepted
- Entries should be mailed to or dropped off at the Macomb County Senior Citizen Services Department, 21885 Dunham Road, Suite 6, Clinton Township, MI, 48036
- Entries must be received by June 1
- For identification, put a name and address on the back of all photos
- Photos will not be returned

People can cast votes at the festival for \$1 each – there is no limit on the number of votes a person can cast. The first-prize winner gets a \$100 gift card, second-prize a \$50 gift card and third-prize a \$25 gift card. Winners will be announced at 3 p.m. the day of the festival.

All proceeds will be donated to senior citizen programs such as Project Fresh or Grandparents Raising Grandchildren.
