## **Senior citizens can get fresh fruit, vegetables with Senior Project FRESH coupons**

MOUNT CLEMENS, Mich. – Income-eligible Macomb County senior citizens can get coupons for discounts on nutritious, vitamin-rich fresh fruits and vegetables from select local farmers markets.

The “Senior Project FRESH” coupons will be available beginning June 1 from the Macomb County Senior Citizens Services Department. The program is for qualified residents who are at least 60 years old.

Senior Project FRESH provides eligible seniors with coupons to purchase unprocessed, locally grown produce. The program aims to provide much-needed nutrition support to low-income seniors. It is supported by the U.S. Department of Agriculture, the Michigan Office of Services to the Aging and local donations.

Seniors who qualify will get 10, \$2 coupons for use at certain farmers markets in Macomb County. The coupons expire Oct. 31.
