Water service to be disrupted; consult your local water department for updates

MOUNT CLEMENS, Mich. – Water service will be disrupted for several Macomb County communities due to repair work that is going to be performed on a leaking water main at Dequindre Road, at the boarder between Rochester Hills and Shelby Township.

Detroit Water and Sewerage Department (DWSD) crews will do the repair work from 7 p.m. Wednesday, July 1, until 7 a.m. Thursday, July 2.

Repairs will impact water service in the following Macomb County communities: Washington Township, Shelby Township, Macomb Township, Chesterfield Township, Harrison Township, Lenox Township, the Village of New Haven, a portion of Romeo served by the DWSD.

DWSD is asking residents in these areas, as well as those living in Clinton Township, Sterling Heights and Utica to refrain from outside water use from noon on Wednesday, July 1, through noon on Thursday, July 2.
