

HIV/AIDS Counseling & Testing

Statutory Authority:

- Public Act 368 of 1978
- Public Act 420 of 1994

- ◆ Provides anonymous HIV counseling & testing on an appointment basis, through Program H, and confidential HIV counseling and testing in the STD/HIV Clinic.
- ◆ Conducts reporting of HIV & AIDS cases to state.
- ◆ Provides partner and referral services.
- ◆ Referrals for case management & other community services.

Sexually Transmitted Disease (STD)

Statutory Authority:

– Public Act 368 of 1978

- ◆ Provides confidential diagnosis and treatment of selected sexually transmitted diseases.
- ◆ Appointment and walk-in clinic services at two (2) Health Center locations with day, evening and afternoon hours.
- ◆ Provides school based group educational Group educational services on request.
- ◆ Provides surveillance and reporting to Michigan Department of Community Health.

Testing and Treatment for:

- ✓ Chlamydia
- ✓ Gonorrhea
- ✓ Syphilis
- ✓ Trichomoniasis
- ✓ Non-gonococcal Urethritis
- ✓ Bacterial Vaginosis
- ✓ Scabies
- ✓ Pubic lice

School Immunization Program

Statutory Authority:

– Public Act 368 of 1978



- ◆ Requires immunization rates of at least 95% for all students entering or attending school, childcare, pre-school or Head Start programs
- ◆ Reports immunization rates for Macomb County students and pre-school aged children to the State of Michigan using the Michigan Childhood Immunization Registry – School Immunization Reporting System (MCIR-SIRS)
- ◆ Enforces exclusion of all under-immunized students, pre-school and childcare attendees

...maintaining high immunization levels for Macomb County students

Hearing & Vision Screening

Statutory Authority:

– Public Act 368 of 1978

- ◆ Free hearing & vision screening, referrals & follow-up supervision for preschool (ages 3-5) and school age children.
- ◆ Delivers services at Macomb County schools, day care centers & other community sites.



...working toward identification of hearing and vision deficits

Breast & Cervical Services

- ◆ Eligible women receive no-cost mammograms, pap smears, pelvic exams and clinical breast exams
- ◆ Provides comprehensive health education services
- ◆ Uses Macomb County hospitals for clinical services
- ◆ Assures that any woman diagnosed with breast or cervical cancer through this program will receive treatment
- ◆ Age, income, insurance and residency eligibility guidelines apply



...providing education and improved access to cancer screenings
